Foal Vaccination/ Deworming Schedule

Foals from mares vaccinated 4-6 weeks before the foal was born:

- " 6 months: EWT, Flu/Rhino, West Nile, Rabies, +/- Strangles
- " 7 months: EWT, Flu/Rhino, West Nile, Rabies, +/- Strangles
- " 12 months: EWT, Flu/Rhino, West Nile, Rabies, +/- Strangles

Foals from unvaccinated mares:

- " 3 months: EWT, Flu/Rhino, West Nile, Rabies
- " 4 months: EWT, Flu/Rhino, West Nile, Rabies
- 5 months: EWT, Flu/Rhino, West Nile, Rabies, +/- Strangles
- " 12 months: EWT, Flu/Rhino, West Nile, Rabies, +/- Strangles

Adults from 1 year or older:

EWT, Flu/Rhino, West Nile, Rabies, +/- Strangles

Flu/Rhino is given every 6 months, the rest are once a year

DEWORMING SCHEDULE

- " 2 months: Anthelcide (Oxibendazole)
- " 4 months: Double dose of Strongid (Pryantel Pamoate)
- 6 months: Do a FEC (fecal egg count) before weaning (around 6 months) and choose accordingly.
- " 9 months: Ivermectin
- " 12 months: Ivermectin
